# TRAINING & ASSESSMENTS (Face to Face) for <u>NEW</u> OFFICIALS: Marker & Measurer <u>OR</u> National Umpire October 2024



**Applications** are invited for **NEW OFFICIALS** to attend a Training & Assessment course.

Attendance is required at each relevant session with each session expected to take approximately 4 hours. Some additional time may be taken up with discussions around Health and Safety, ongoing learning as a new umpire and to complete end of course interviews/assessment feedback.

**Session 1 – Marker**: Consists of on-green and classroom training.

**Session 2 – Measurer**: Consists of Marking Assessment plus how to use measuring instruments ongreen and the applicants demonstrating their competency with those instruments. It also includes some classroom learning of the Laws pertaining to measuring.

**Session 3 – National Umpire:** Consists of Measuring Assessment plus classroom learning of the Laws of The Sport of Bowls.

To become a National Umpire you must attend and accredit at all three sessions.

(Marker/Measurer accreditation requires attendance at Sessions 1&2 and the first part of Session 3)

Assessment includes tests, demonstration of your on-green skills and your participation in the classroom training.
