

Applications are invited for **REACCREDITING OFFICIALS** to attend an assessment session.

Applicants will be required to answer 5 Marker and 5 Measurer or 15 National Umpire questions as well as undergo a number of on-green practical marking and/or measuring assessments. There will also be a short seminar to cover changes to rules. The total time to complete the course is expected to be 3 to 4 hours.

<u>Please note</u>: This course includes measuring and candidates will be assessed on their physical ability to use measuring equipment that requires a steady hand and bending down to work at ground level.
